GUIDELINES for Requesting a Letter of Good Standing for Non-Clergy

Per the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) guidelines, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles requires non-clergy to request a **Letter of Good Standing** which is sent to the Chancery of the (Arch)diocese where ministry will be exercised. A copy of the letter may also be sent to the parish being visited.

To request a Letter of Good Standing, please provide the following information and send it to: Archdiocese of Los Angeles, Office of the Chancellor, 3424 Wilshire Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90010-2241, at least four weeks prior to the request date of ministry for this to be processed accordingly and in a timely manner:

- 1. Your complete name and title, home address, phone number and email address
- 2. <u>Home</u> parish, name of pastor and complete address (including city and zip)
- 3. Current ministry, i.e., catechist, school teacher, campus minister, staff of a Catholic institution, retreat leader, paid staff, volunteer, other
- 4. Reason for Request
 - a. Specific details regarding event, retreat, conference, presentation, etc. i.e., event theme
 - b. Title of presentation, date(s), time(s) and specific location, i.e., name and address of venue if other than a parish (see 6. below)
- 5. (Arch)diocese being visited
 - a. Include name of Bishop, (Arch)diocese and complete address
- 6. Parish being visited
 - a. Include name of pastor and name and address of parish
- 7. <u>Verification from pastor</u> that there are no impediments or incapacities which may adversely affect one's ability to serve as a speaker, etc.
- 8. Verification speaker has participated in an adult training program for the protection of children and young people (VIRTUS® or a recognized equivalent) and has been background checked:
 - a. Copy of most recent "Certificate of Training Attendance"
 - b. Proof of background clearance, i.e., copy of "Request for Live Scan Service" or equivalent

Once we have received the required information and documentation, your request for a Letter of Good Standing will be prepared and forwarded to the visiting (Arch)diocese.
