2. It was only a misdemeanor or other minor offense;
3. You didn't have to go to court (your attorney went for you);
4. You had no jail time or the sentence was only a fine or probation;
5. You received a certificate of rehabilitation;
6. If the conviction was later dismissed, set aside or the sentence was suspended.
