<p>TESTING ADAPTATIONS</p> <p>Extra time on tests/quizzes</p> <p>Distraction limited testing</p> <p>Simplify test questions</p> <p>Test read to/with student</p> <p>Allow student to fix test errors to improve understanding and grade</p> <p>Alternative assessments (allow student to demonstrate what he/she has learned)</p>	<p>ACADEMICS</p> <p>Consistent rules and consequences</p> <p>Break multiple-step problems into small steps</p> <p>Use of visual aids and graphic organizers</p> <p>Repeat/rephrase information</p> <p>Prompt student to task or lecture</p> <p>Check for comprehension/have student repeat information</p> <p>Front load vocabulary and concepts before new content</p> <p>Manipulatives to build math and science concepts (classroom only)</p> <p>Tutor student after school</p>
<p>TIME MANAGEMENT/MOTIVATION</p> <p>Canvas: calendar/planner</p> <p>Reminders about upcoming deadlines</p> <p>Verbal praise/positive reinforcement</p> <p>Pair student with friendly student during breakout sessions</p> <p>Allow student to turn off camera after attendance during Zoom sessions and stay engaged with chat feature.</p>	<p>OTHER</p>
