

## Parent/Student Tech Agreement

\*The following is a condensed version of the sections found in the Parent/Student Handbook on the St. Francis de Sales School Website. Please make sure to read in detail each section.\*

- Personal Devices: Students are strongly discouraged from bringing cell phones, apple watches,
  or other electronic devices to school. If a device is brought to school, the student will need to
  turn it into the teacher in the morning. Consequences will be enforced.
- Technology Privacy: The iPad and other technology devices are tools for schoolwork only, I
  understand that if I access an App or site not directed by my teacher, my iPad will be
  confiscated
- Online Privacy: To protect my identity, personal information such as my last name, address, telephone number, school name, cell phone number, screen name, and password is never to be given out
- **Legal Issues:** I am aware that vandalism of equipment will not be tolerated. I will not install or download anything found on the Internet
- Copyright and Plagiarism: I will cite all my resources with proper research format for all text and other research items used
- Safety Issues: I will not use the iPad or any other technology device to participate in cyber bullying. If I come across any communications that are inappropriate, I will notify my instructor immediately. If I become aware of any student participating in cyber bullying I will notify my instructor and/or administrator. If I come across anything (picture, ad, website, etc.) on the Internet that is inappropriate then I will let the instructor know so corrective action can be taken.
- Social Media and Other Technologies: I understand SFDS does not support or approve of the use of social media under the age-required limits set by the social media terms of service. Facebook and other social media sites are not a school function. As the primary educators of their children, it is the parents' responsibility to monitor social media and its correct use. Social media should be aligned with and reflect Catholic values in content created and posted by the individual user. Should an issue regarding posts, comments, or other social media interactions be brought to the school's attention, the school may exercise its right to administer disciplinary action for those involved.
- Google Suite for Education: I understand that the applications in GSUITE are for educational purposes only. I will not use my school provided email to communicate regarding personal matters

The student will be held responsible for any damages beyond normal wear and tear. Students will be fiscally responsible for replacing the damaged device.
